FILM THEME

Anything in relation to being a nurse/nursing/midwife/midwifery.

GUIDELINES

AND CONDITIONS

- You must be a financial member or associate member of the NSW Nurses and Midwives' Association.
- Your film must have a nurse/midwife in it.
- Your film must not be longer than 5 minutes, including credits.
- Your film must be original.
- Have been produced specifically for this festival.
- Be submitted in DVD format.
- You must obtain licences for all music (both compositions and sound recordings) incorporated into your film sufficient to allow the NSW Nurses and Midwives' Association to exhibit and promote your film in accordance with this agreement.
- You grant the NSW Nurses and Midwives' Association a non exclusive licence in respect of your film (or any extract) in perpetuity to:
 - (a) Exhibit to paying or non-paying audiences;
 - (b) reproduce on DVDs and distribute on a not-for-profit basis; and
 - (c) communicate to the public by means of the NSW Nurses and Midwives' Association website.
- You warrant that your film does not infringe the rights of any third party, including breach of confidentiality, breach of copyright, trespass, defamation or any other claim, and you indemnify the NSW Nurses and Midwives' Association against any loss arising from any such claim.
- If you have filmed at your, or another worksite, or any other private premises, permission in writing must be obtained from management to film on site.
- No names on badges, ID cards/bracelets or hospital/facility names must be identifiable.
- Your script must be original.
- If you are submitting more than one film, please submit with separate DVDs and entry form.
- All details in your entry must be true.
- You have not given rights to your entry to anyone prior to entering this competition.

ENTRIES

YOUR ENTRY MUST INCLUDE:

- A completed, concise and signed entry form. Incomplete forms will be forfeited.
- A digital copy on USB (1280x720p or higher) .mov or .mp4.
- 2 copies of your DVD clearly labelled with film title and your name.
- Signed consent forms from all actors and others appearing in your film.
- Signed consent forms from management clearing the use of their facility.
- 2 stills photographs taken during filming (for promotional purposes).
- Entries must be received by the NSWNMA by 14 April 2017.
