Topics Covered:

- **Skin Integrity**

Explore causative factors and preventive measures in improving our older peoples' skin integrity. Improve your quality indicators for pressure injuries, Incontinence Associated Dermatitis, consumer experience and quality of life as well as preventing Serious Incidents through a multi team approach.

- **Nutrition and Hydration**

This session will explore health outcomes, challenges and strategies to improve the quality of life of older people focusing on food and drink.

- **Dysphasia and choking**
